The amount of funding we receive for providing free school meals to all children in Years R, 1 and 2 is based on the number of children who actually take a school meal on that day. Therefore **please encourage your Key Stage 1 child** to have a school meal on this day. We are swapping the Thursday and Friday menus over next week, so the choices on Thursday will be Fish Finger wrap (red choice) or Cheese, Tomato & Onion pasty (green choice.)

If you think your child may be eligible for free school meals, (even if they are in Key Stage 1 and currently receiving Infant Free School Meals anyway) please ask at the school as soon as possible. We can do a quick online check on your behalf; we just need your date of birth and National Insurance number. This attracts additional Pupil Premium funding for the school and would enable us to help with costs such as school trips. Thank you.
