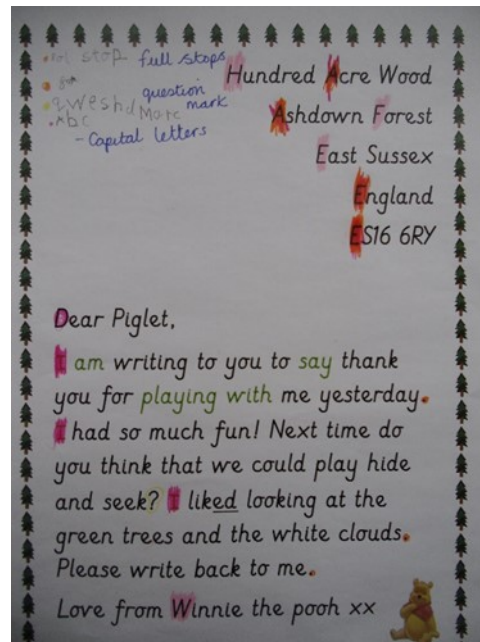
### Football vs Warsash
