Attendance

Please could I ask for your continued support in ensuring that your children attend school regularly and are punctual. I am pleased to inform you that our attendance rate for last year was 96.1% - many thanks. Also, 28 children managed to go through the whole year with 100% attendance – a super achievement!

The school gates are opened at 8.45 a.m., with registration shortly after at 8.55 a.m. and all children should be in class at this time. It is very disruptive for children and teaching staff if children arrive into the classrooms after the school day has begun. A reminder that the school day ends at 3.30 p.m.

Health & Well-being

If your child uses an inhaler, however infrequently, or requires access to emergency medical treatment (e.g. Epi-pens), please ensure the school is fully aware and holds the appropriate supply of the necessary medication (within its use-by date.) It is regarded as recommended practice for schools to have duplicates of inhalers so that one is with the child (in class) and one is in the Medical Room. All medication should be in date and you are asked to check this and replace as appropriate.

Parent Access to School in the morning

In the interests of maintaining a safe and secure school, please leave your child to enter class unaccompanied by you. This ensures that we know who is on the premises and whose safety we need to account for. The class teacher is available for a quick chat should the need arise first thing, but if a longer appointment is required, please arrange through the office. Your co-operation would be very much appreciated.

Clubs

A list of the clubs on offer this term will be sent home on Monday and will be allocated on a first come first served basis in some instances.

Handing in Paperwork

We are very keen to encourage all children to take responsibility for handing in paperwork to their class teachers. Each morning teachers collect any items the children need to hand in and they are then passed on to the office. Please help us by encouraging your children to hand in any money, paperwork, notes, vouchers etc. direct to their class teachers which will then help morning and evening congestion at reception. Many thanks for your support.

Dinner Money

Please ensure that all dinner monies are paid in advance. If you are unsure of the amounts outstanding please contact the school office. Thank you for your cooperation.
