Grow £1 Challenge

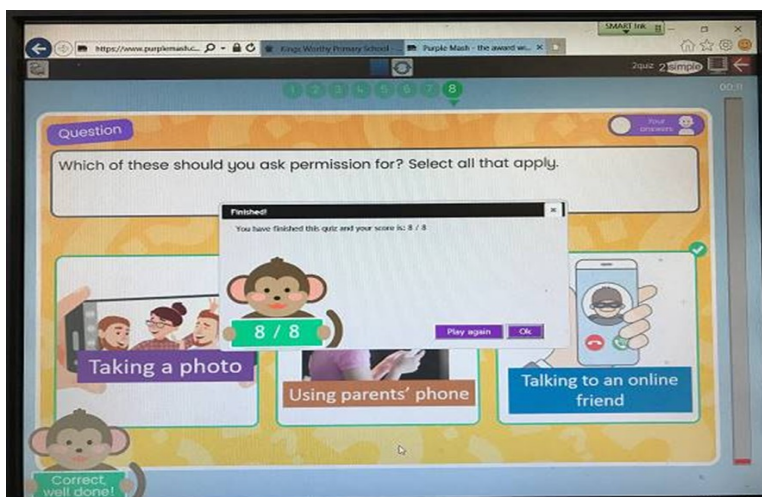

Safer Internet Day

All classes were involved in activities on Tuesday for Safer Internet Day, including taking part in PurpleMash's Biggest Online Safety Lesson together with 700,000 other children across the country.



This year's theme is 'Consent' and the children have watched information from the UK Safer Internet Centre in separate Key Stage assemblies. Through these materials, the children have been encouraged to protect their personal information, to check with an adult before entering personal information into apps that they use and to ask for permission first before sharing photos of other people.

If you were lucky enough to be in the hall you will have seen a mesmerising performance with so many messages about internet safety. It was full of acting, singing, dancing and such a wonderful clarity of voice by all involved. I said to Miss Keeble that she should video the performance and send it off to the internet safety website – it was that good! Well done to all the children and to Miss Keeble for putting such a great assembly together.

I'll leave you with what was for me their most important message – even though it was safer internet day on Tuesday, staying safe online is so important for everyone for every day of the year.
