Year 5 afternoon visit to Winchester College, 23 May 2018

Dear Parents,

As part of our geography work, we have been invited to visit Winchester College to gain an understanding of the importance of the River Itchen chalk stream that flows through their grounds and to investigate some of the creatures and plants that live in it. Both 5K and 5B will take part in a river study. The activities will be led by College staff at a ratio of 1:6 and accompanied by staff from Kings Worthy, and the children will not be going in the water. There is no charge for this trip as minibus transport is provided by Winchester College.

On 23 May, Year 5 will leave school at 1.00pm, and return by 3.30pm traffic permitting. All children will have lunch at school as usual before leaving, and light refreshments will also be provided by the College at the end of the visit. School uniform should be worn as usual on the day and the children will also need to bring a waterproof coat and wellies/boots/strong shoes to change into.
