New Year R Intake Story Time

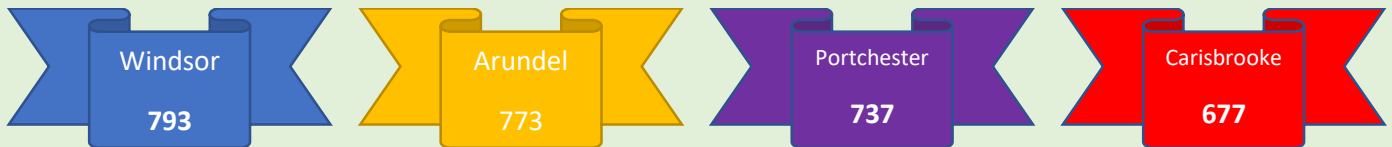
