This week saw posts showing off our incredible Woodland Walk as well as the return of clubs.

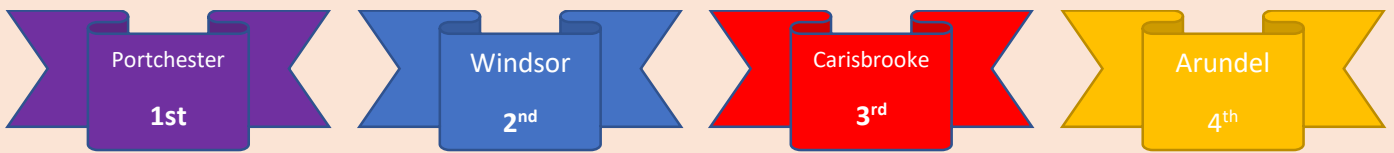
