

The Three Little Pigs - Play script

Characters: Narrator, Mother, Pig 1, Pig2, Pig3, Man, Wolf

Scene 1 - Mother Pig's house in the village. It is a small village with happy and friendly people. The three little pigs are stood outside with their bags packed up ready to leave home. It is a warm summer's day and everyone is happy and excited.

Narrator: Once upon a time, three pigs left their mother's home and went into the world.

Three Pigs: (Happily) Bye Mother!

Mother: Good-bye my little sons.

(The pigs start to walk away in different directions.)

Narrator: The three pigs went different ways. Soon pig 1 met a man who was selling straw.

(Pig 1 goes up to the man and waves happily at him.)

Pig 1: I need some straw, would you sell it to me?

Man: (With a deep, low voice) Of course! Take it!

(Pig 1 gives some money to the man, thanks him and walks off with his straw)

Narrator: Later, Pig 2 met a man who was selling wood.

(Pig 1 goes up to the man and waves happily at him.)

Pig 2: Please Sir, I need some wood to build my house. Would you sell it to me?

Man: (Excitedly) Yes. Take it.

Narrator: Pig 2 paid the man and went on his way to make his wood house. Later, Pig 3 met a man who was selling bricks.

Pig 3: Excuse me Sir, I need some bricks. Are they for sale?

Man: (With a quiet husky voice) Of course. Take them.

Narrator: Pig 3 paid the man and went on his way to build his brick house.

(The three pigs all have their straw, wood, and bricks and begin to build their houses outside the village).

Narrator: When the three pigs finished their houses they moved in. Pig 1 was taking a nap when someone knocked at the door.

(Pig 1 is asleep but jumps up when he hears the knock on the door).

Wolf: (In a loud threatening voice.) Little pig, little pig, let me in!

Pig 1: (In a squeaky, scared voice.) Not by the hair on my chinny-chin-chin.

Wolf: (Bellowing) Then I' ll huff and I' ll puff and I' ll blow your house down!!

(The wolf starts to blow the house down and pig 1 runs away terrified. The house is left as a pile of straw)

Narrator: The wolf huffed and puffed and destroyed pig 1's house. Pig 1 ran all the way to pig 2's house. When he got there Pig 1 told Pig 2 what had happened. Pig 2 invited Pig 1 to live with him. After a few days, there was a knock at the door. The two pigs looked out the window and it was the wolf.

(Pig 1 and 2 are busy making dinner. When they hear the knock, they both jump and run to the window)

Wolf: (Bellowing) Little pigs, Little pigs, let me in!

Pig 1 & 2: (Together in squeaky voices) Not by the hairs on our chinny-chin-chins.

Wolf: Then I' ll huff and I' ll puff and I' ll blow your house down.

(The wolf stands with his hands on his hips and begins to blow the house down with big breaths. The two pigs huddle together inside before running out the back door when the house starts to collapse.)
