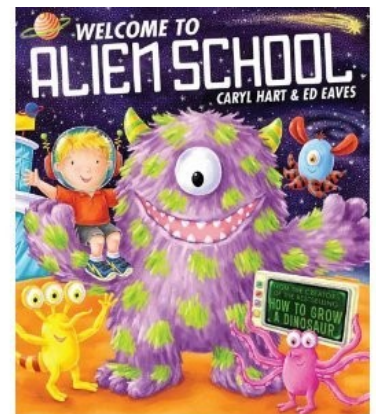

WHAT ARE YEAR 1 UP TO?

## English

During the first half term in English, children in Year 1 will be exploring how to write labels, lists and captions. They will begin by labelling their own creations and making lists for different real-life purposes. Following on from this, the children will be writing their own captions for their own rocket creations. They will also have the opportunity to practise all these skills through our ongoing provision to develop their independence with reading and writing.



In addition to our main English lessons, children will continue to have daily phonics sessions. We are currently recapping all of the level 4 sounds as well as beginning to learn the new level 5 sounds. All of these sounds can be



found in the middle of their reading diaries which have now been given out to all children. Once they have their reading dairies, they should be in school every day and if reading has been recorded at least 4 times in a week they will earn 3 house points.

# Maths

In maths this term the children will start by focusing on place value and understanding how much a number is worth between 0 and 20. They will be using a range of resources to make numbers, identifying one more and one less and sorting objects into groups. They will then move on to adding and subtracting numbers using both resources and number lines. Alongside this the children will be exploring weight, length and capacity through our ongoing provision as well as shape in a variety of different ways both inside and out of the classroom.

## Everything else...

Throughout the term the children will have opportunities to develop their understanding in a range of curriculum areas.

On a Friday morning Year 1 have indoor PE. This half term we will be doing gymnastics where they will learn a range of different shapes and skills, putting this together into a routine. After half term the focus will be dance. On a Tuesday afternoon the children will have outdoor PE.

Please ensure that the children have a PE kit in school at all times - this should be a pair of white shorts or plain leggings/ joggers and a t-shirt in the appropriate colour for their house. We also ask that you provide a spare pair of socks and some underwear in their PE kits in case of any accidents.

On a Tuesday afternoon Mrs Atkins and Mrs Sibbons are in Year 1 and they will be teaching Thrive time and PE.

In Geography the children will be learning about the local environment in our topic 'All Around Us'. They will be learning about the differences between villages, towns, cities and countries and using maps and atlases to help them.

This half term our Science unit is 'Weather and Seasons' which we will explore alongside our 'All Around Us' topic, and next half term it is 'Materials' which will link in with our Toys topic.

In Art, the children will be learning about collage using a range of materials and techniques to create different effects. They will also be looking at the work of Megan Coyle, a British collage artist, whose work will inspire their final pieces.

In RE we are thinking about things we are thankful for. We are learning about how Christians celebrate Harvest and how Jewish people celebrate Sukkot.
