I would like to confirm that the final day of term is next **Friday 17th December**.

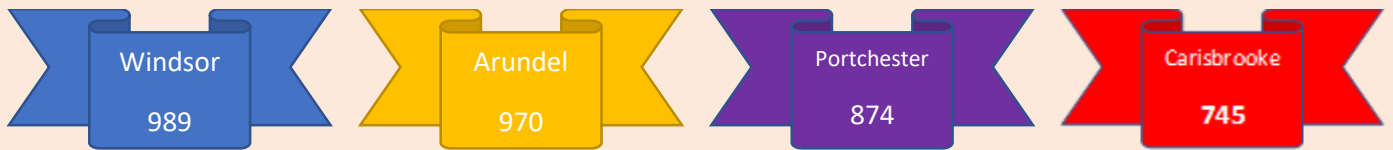
Timings for the final Friday collection for all children will be **1.15pm**.
