At lunchtime, we will enjoy our own school tea party and (weather dependant!) will enjoy a whole school picnic on the field. 10 Outstandings!

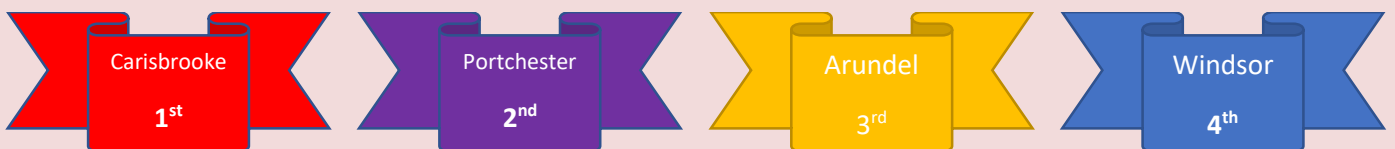
