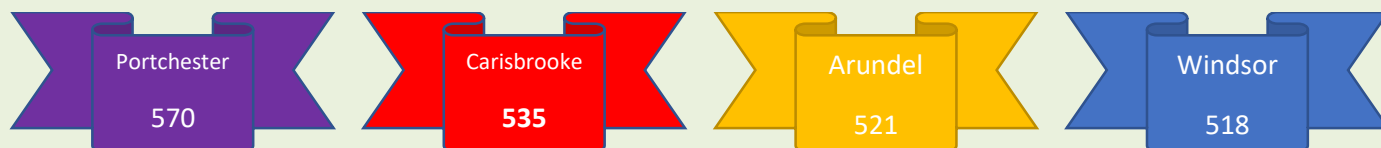

## Hannukah

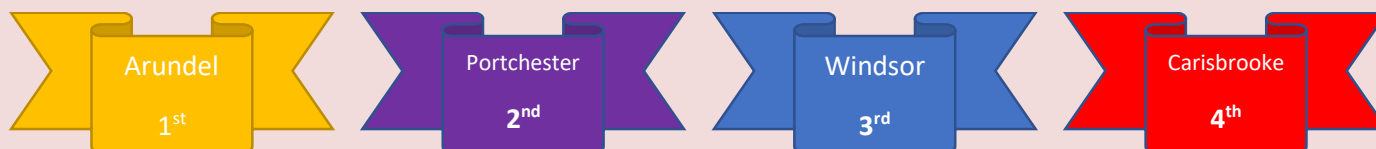
